





Hello all! My name is Father James Prins. I am a newly ordained priest for the Diocese of London, and I am blessed to begin my ministry in the London North Central Catholic Family of Parishes!



I grew up just north of London in a large family - I am one of nine children. After school, I worked as part of a construction team building houses and maintaining properties around London. Although I enjoyed my job, I did not feel completely at peace with construction as a career. I began to investigate the priesthood, to which I had felt a call since childhood.

As I began to attend daily Mass and spend more time in silent Eucharistic adoration, I became increasingly certain that God was calling me to become a priest. I went to college to study philosophy, and after I graduated, I began studying theology at St. Peter's Seminary here in London. I graduated from the seminary this past April and was ordained a priest on April 27th.





Date: Thursday, August 15, 2024


The cost is \$38 per person, to be paid at the time of reservation (no refund, please).
