

Not An Ordinary Life



St. Peter's Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP)

This past April, St. Peter's Saint Vincent de Paul Society made 49 visits to help 74 people who asked for our assistance. Gift cards worth \$3,260 were given to these people as well as 17 vouchers from our York St. store for furniture, clothing and household items. Here is a story about of one of our clients:

"Tim is one recipient of our help. He was severely injured some years ago when a can of WD-40 exploded in his face; he lost an eye and required extensive reconstructive surgery. No longer able to work as a cook, he now survives with ODSP support. Despite his handicap, he is always looking out for others in his apartment building, providing what help he can when they need food or other assistance. What is remarkable is that Tim always seems able to offer insightful comments on our own personal lives when we call on him. He tells us that he received this gift only after his accident almost cost him his life. He also invariably expresses gratitude for the assistance we provide."
